

## Rule Clarifications & Variations - NFL Flag

- I. Rule Clarifications
  - a. General Rulebook Highlights
    - i. Variations on all Divisions
      - 1. Line up 3 Yards Off Line of Scrimmage (Defense)
      - 2. 20 Minute Halves (Rather than 24 Minutes)
      - 3. Each Team gets 2 TOs per Half (Rather than 1)
      - Center may Snap the Ball from Between the Legs or from Side if down on one knee; Kindergarten/1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Graders may stand, but must have ball on ground
    - ii. Home/Away Jerseys
      - 1. Home Team should wear lighter colored jersey
      - 2. Away Team should wear darker colored jersey
    - iii. 1st Down and Touchdowns
      - 1. Each team has the opportunity for 4 downs to get to mid-field (1st down marker). After 3 downs, if the offensive team has not reached the first down marker, the coach has two options, Play or Punt. If the coach chooses to "Play", the offensive team will have a 4th down play that they must convert or the result is a turnover at the current spot where the ball is down. If the offensive coach chooses to "Put", the referee will place the ball on the 5 yard line of the opposite side of the field for the turnover.
      - 2. If the offensive team gets a first down, advancing beyond mid-field, the offensive team will have 3 downs to get a touchdown. If the 3<sup>rd</sup> down play is not successful in getting a touchdown, the ball is placed at the 5 yard line for an automatic turnover to the other team.
    - iv. Rushing the Passer
      - 1. Only 2 defensive players may rush at any one time. Each of these one or two players declaring to rush must line up behind the 7 yard cone marker on the field. Defense is not required to rush.
      - 2. If the QB is rushed, he/she may run the ball if and only if the rusher has breached the line of scrimmage. This is the only scenario where a passer may run with the ball without the ball having previously been handed off.

- b. Kindergarten Division Rule Variations
  - i. Coach can act as Quarterback in Gameplay, but is not Required to do so
    - 1. 5 Players on Field
    - 2. One Step from Snapped Ball (No Running Around)
  - ii. No "No Run" Zones
  - iii. No Rushing the Passer at any time
  - iv. On Defense, Coach may be on the field but must be out of area of play (10 yards back when ball is snapped)
- c. 1st & 2nd Grade Division Rule Variations
  - i. No "No Run" Zones
  - ii. No Rushing the Passer at any time
  - iii. On Offense & Defense, Coach may be on the field but must be out of area of play (5 yards back when ball is snapped)
- d. Coach Position Clarifications on Other Divisions
  - 1. 3rd & 4th Grade Division
    - a. Offense Coach May Be in Huddle, Back 5 Yards for Gameplay
    - b. Defense Coach Must Remain on Sidelines
  - 2. 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Division
    - a. Offense Coach May Enter Huddle to Call Play, Must be on Sideline for Snapped Ball
    - b. Defense Coach Must Remain on Sidelines
  - 3. 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Division
    - a. Offense Coach May Enter Huddle to Call Play, Must be on Sideline for Snapped Ball
    - b. Defense Coach Must Remain on Sidelines
